

## Flight Line Cruise Information

The Flight Line Cruise is planned for approximately 12:35pm each day; please note that this schedule may be adjusted to accommodate changes to the Airshow schedule due to weather, performers' needs, etc.

Drivers: Please be at your vehicle, ready to move to the staging area at 11:45am.

Follow all directions of the Cherry's Jubilee staff and volunteers – you will be guided to the staging area and will then follow the lead car onto the flight line.

A photo of your vehicle will be taken while on the cruise; photos will be available for download within 2 weeks of the event.

At the end of the cruise there will be an option for an early exit; if you plan to leave after the cruise, please have all of your belongings gathered and in your vehicle in advance of staging for the cruise. Your vehicle will NOT be able to re-enter the event after you exit.

## Rules and Reminders:

Drivers must be age 18 or older to drive on airport property at any time during the event

NO use of modified suspensions, airbags, etc. <u>while vehicle is in motion</u>

Speed limit throughout the cruise route is 15 mph

All riders must be seated; Riding in truck beds is not permitted

Stay inside your vehicle at all times

No burn outs or exhibitions of speed will be tolerated

<u>Important</u>: If your vehicle breaks down while on the flight line and cannot be immediately restarted, Airshow staff will relocate your vehicle **using tow straps** and an airshow vehicle. Tow trucks, flatbeds, etc. will not be available and the flight line must be cleared at the end of the cruise.
